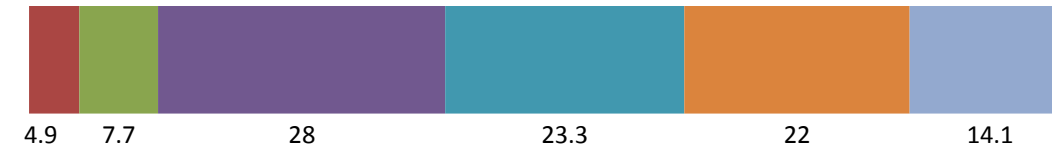


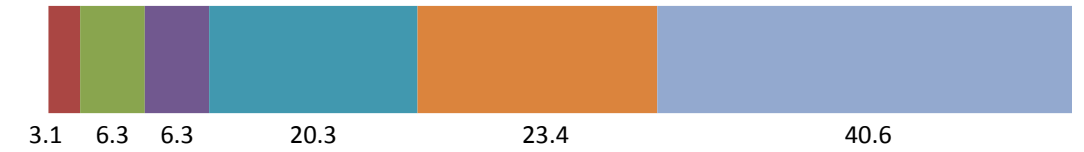
In American university classes, every week, more textbook reading homework is given than in Japan's classes.

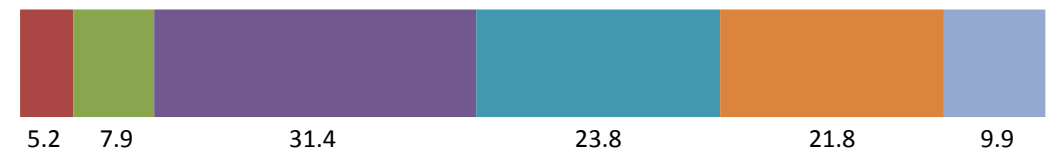
In American university classes, every week, more textbook reading homework is given than in Japan's classes.
