Most American students visit their professors during office hours at least a few times each semester.



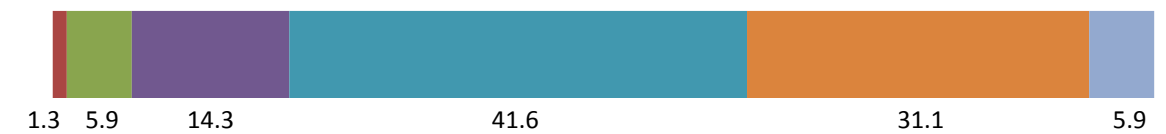
Students who feel rather strongly that US students wouldn't be surprised by a lecturer (n=98) vs.

Students who think US uni students would not be surprised by a lecturer (n=238) vs.



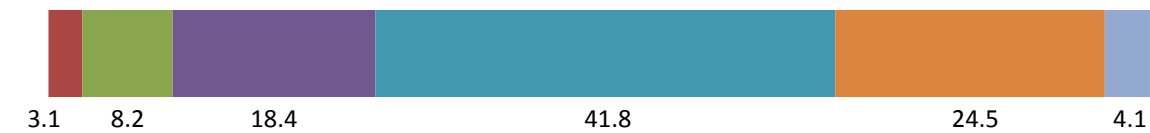
students who think US uni students would regard a lecturer as strange or unusual (n=230). The p-value here is 0.0004061 and the phi-coefficient/Cramer's V is: 0.163



Students who think informal debate is a common activity in US uni classes (n=370) vs.



students who think informal debate is not a common class activity (n=98). The p-value here is 1.76E-005 and the phi-coefficient/Cramer's V is: 0.198



Students who think "It will be necessary for me to frequently write complete essays with a 2 to 3 hour time limit in class time in my classes abroad (n=245) vs.



students who do not think they will need to do this kind of timed writing (n=223). The p-value here is 0.0007488 and the phi-coefficient/Cramer's V is: 0.156
